 - 3.2.1 The Library has returned to its pre-holiday form. The Giving Forest has been dismantled, 10 boxes of food were donated to the food bank
 - 3.2.2 There are currently 2 staff members absent and isolating, due to positive Covid-19 status..
 - 3.2.3 The local Chamber of Commerce has provided the Library with Rapid Test Kits.
 - 3.2.4 Issues with anti-maskers have increased in frequency and severity. To help staff navigate these issues Dan Galway has created a decision tree and some disciplinary guidelines
