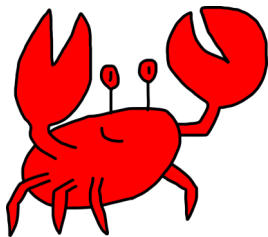

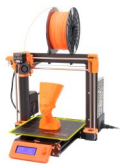
Adult Summer Programming

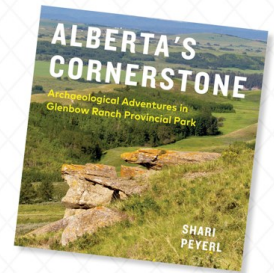

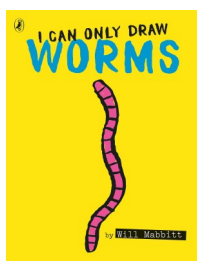


Summer Reading Club

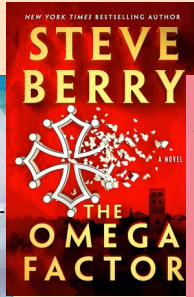
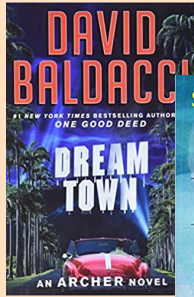
Last Round for Garden Ready Greens

In early-August we will have Basil plants in library available for purchase. This will be the last of the plant sales with all proceeds supporting the library. Plants will be available for sale for a few weeks.

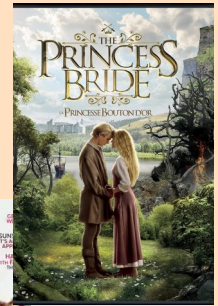
