This November the SILENT AUCTION will return offering community residents a great opportunity to do some holiday shopping while supporting their local library.

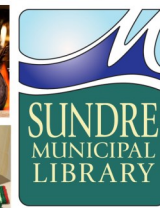

Dried Grass & Flower Fundraiser

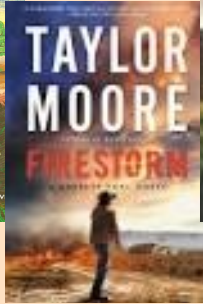
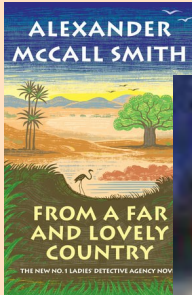
